1. All artwork submitted must be created on a standard 22” and 28” poster board and weigh no more than 2 lbs. **The deadline for submissions is January 26, 2020. Submissions are limited to one per applicant.**
2. Contestants will photograph their work and email it to UN75@state.gov (submissions must be in JPEG format and under 10MB in size and of at least 300dpi resolution).
3. Contestants must be between 13–15 years old on the date of entry into the contest and have parental or legal guardian consent. See further eligibility requirements below.
4. By entering this contest, applicants agree to the “The Future We Want” Youth Art Contest Official Rules.


